To see or be seen?

The choice is yours

One of the first steps in choosing decorative glass is to decide whether you want to enhance the beautiful view outside, or create a stylish way to prevent the outside world from looking in. Before you pick the overall design, select the appropriate obscurity level based on where the glass will be located and what you're looking to achieve.

Obscurity levels



Obscurity levels range from 1 to 4.

- 1 – Clear glass
- 2 – Minster glass
- 3 – Stippolyte glass
- 4 – Silver Mist glass

Follow the guide opposite to see how the different levels can work in certain areas of your home.

Product suitability



Etched glass options



Positive: The pattern is sandblasted on clear glass, but the window is mainly transparent.

Ideal for: Windows, porch doors and conservatory windows.

Obscurity level: 1-2



Negative: The background is sandblasted on clear glass, the design is the only transparent area.

Ideal for: Windows without views e.g. looking out to a wall or fence, suitable for porch doors and conservatory windows.

Obscurity level: 2-3

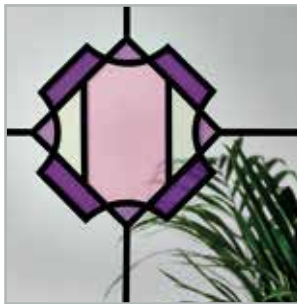


Silver Mist: The pattern is sandblasted on Silver Mist glass, to give you full privacy.

Ideal for: Front doors and bathroom windows.

Obscurity level: 4

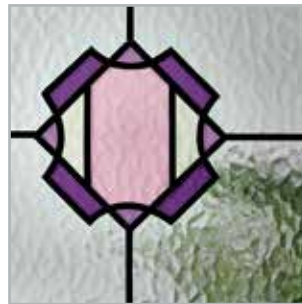

Available in: Brilliant cut, Fusion and Coloured.

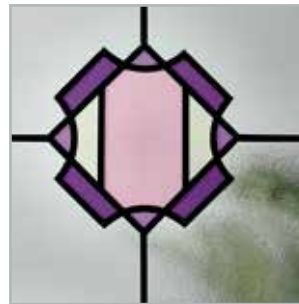

Ideal for: Windows without views e.g. walls or foliage, skylights, porch doors.

Obscurity level: 2-3

Available in: Coloured.

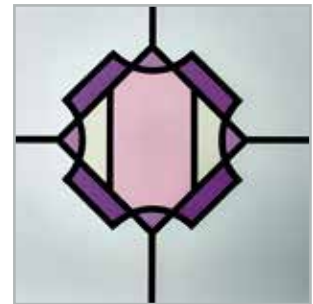

Ideal for: Front doors and bathroom windows and conservatories.

Window designs

Brilliant cut creates crisp, clean lines for a subtle yet sophisticated effect which still allows plenty of light to flood in. 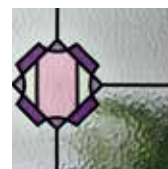
Traditional window fanlights
